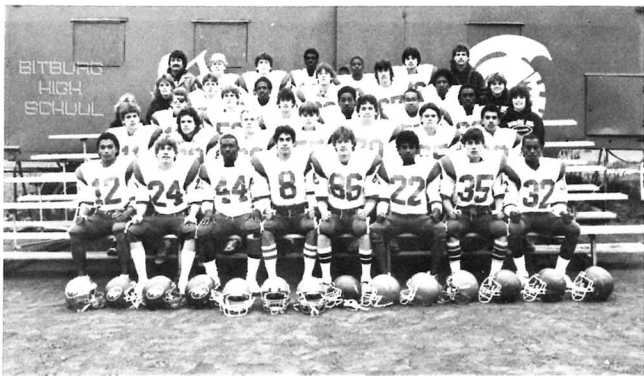


Football Has Disappointing Season
