

# Men's Soccer: Ya Gotta Have 'Em

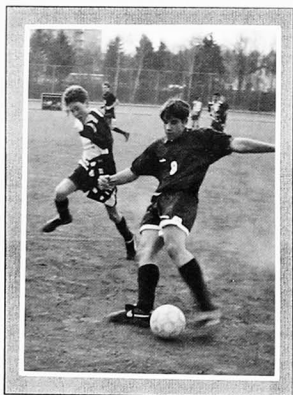
