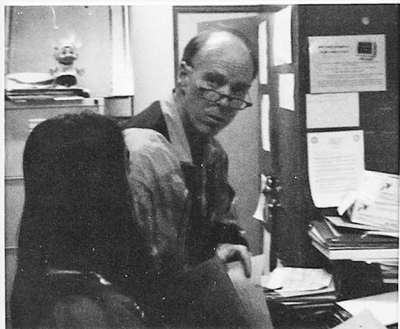
BHS has always had a tradition of a strong men's soccer program. This year should be no different.
