Track looks hopeful for the 1997 season. With several returning European runners and a team full of heart, success is on its way.

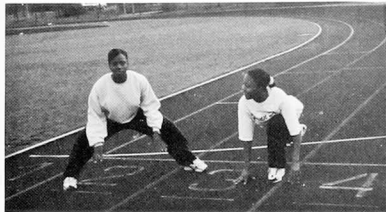

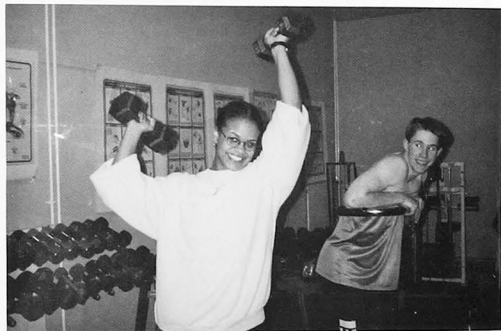
