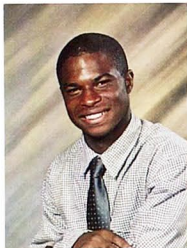


# SENIORS:

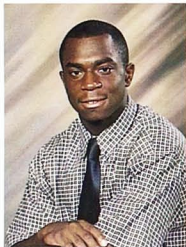

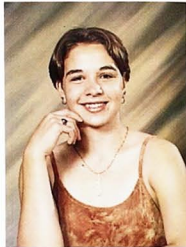
**Samuel Herring**

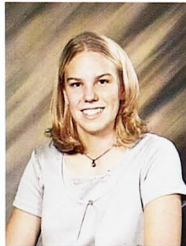
