Thanks to Ms. Elder, our BHS History Day Coordinator, National History Day (NHD) has become a tradition and much anticipated event at our school.

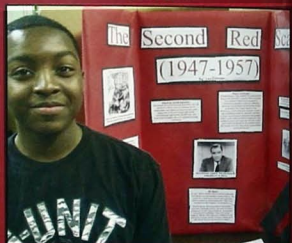
This year's theme, Conflict and Compromise, led to many interesting topics from the Donner Party to women's rights.
