

Boys' Tennis

The Baron men swept through the season undefeated turning a trick that no previous team had done in the last fifteen years. They put down four division I schools on their way to an undefeated 7-0 record for the season. In fact, they and Heidelberg were the only undefeated tennis teams in Europe this year. Their excellence started at the top of the ladder with #1 Tyler Jakobs also battling through the weekends undefeated. On the ladies' side, Bitburg had its female ace also. Sophomore Kaitlyn Miller rose from last season's middle of the ladder ranks to the #1 position.

Playing in this slot she finished 6-1 losing in regional play only to European runner-up Lindsey Jones of Ramstein. Captain Zoe Whitney, a senior, closed out her Baron career successfully dominating play on two particular Saturdays against Kaiserlautern and Baumholder. In men's championship doubles play, Tim Liebig and John McCrea represented the team and entered the tournament as the 7th seed. They were upset in the initial round of the tournament, but recovered to play excellently in the consolation rounds ultimately finishing at their seed position of 7th place. At the European Championships the team scored fifteen points to finish in 2nd place for Division II competition behind the Overseas School of Rome.
