

London Snaps Lakenheath's Victory Skein

LONDON (Special) — The London High Bobcats came from behind with 16 points in the final quarter Saturday to topple Lakenheath High, 51-49, and gain a split in two-game Western Division series after the Lancers scored a 59-49 triumph on Friday.

Apaches Sweep Bearkats

AUGSBURG, Germany (Special)—Sparked by Greg Granderson's 73 points, unbeaten Augsburg rolled to its fifth and sixth straight victories here last weekend, defeating Bad Kreuznach, 92-59 Friday and 53-33 Saturday.

In the battle for the top spot in Red Division standings, Augsburg remained one game behind Mannheim, 8-0, which defeated

Berlin, 53-51 in overtime and 54-42.
