HERE IS YOUR ITINERARY!**February 16, 1973 - Friday**

Departing from selected starting point our motor coach travels through the night northward leaving Germany behind and entering Holland.

February 17, 1973 - Saturday

A Dutch Breakfast will be served in the morning en route. Upon arrival in Amsterdam a tour by motor launch on the picturesque canals will provide the best way to become more acquainted with the real Amsterdam. After our boat ride, the bus will take you to our hotel for accommodations. The remainder of the afternoon and evening is free of organized activity so you may find for yourself the charms of the largest city of Holland. A visit of the famous "Rijksmuseum" is suggested, housing the many Rembrandts, Steens, Hals or the Modern Art Museum containing a huge collection of Van Gogh's painting. You will be free to discover the many delights of Amsterdam and its nightlife in the evening.

February 18, 1973 - Sunday

Breakfast at Hotel.

This whole day will be free for independent activity.

Optional tour leaving hotel after breakfast at 9.00 a.m. to visit The Hague, the seat of the Dutch government. On a short sightseeing tour we shall see the "Binnenhof" (inner courtyard of the Palace of the former Counts of Holland) and the "Ridderzaal" (Knight's Hall), the Peace Palace, housing the International Court of Justice, and other sights of interest. Proceeding further to Scheveningen, we stop enroute to visit Madurodam, the miniature Dutch town (if open). Driving on to the North Sea Pleaureland Scheveningen, Hollands most fashionable seaside resort, we pass along the beach promenade to view the picturesque old fishing harbor. Leaving The Hague and Scheveningen we arrive in Amsterdam at our hotel in the early evening. Lunch not included, but can be taken independently at Scheveningen.

Amsterdam's nightlife will be in full swing again at the nearby Leidse or Rembrandtplein. Ask your escort for assistance to plan your evening. Additional charge for the optional tour to The Hague and Scheveningen \$3.00 if at least 15 participants sign up.

February 19, 1973 - Monday

Breakfast at hotel. In the morning we bid goodbye to lovely Amsterdam and Holland, and head south into Germany. Lunch stop en route but not included. We reach our points of origination in the evening.
