

Hanau men, Frankfurt women win

FRANKFURT — A pair of relay victories and Mark Hughes' two wins in middle distance races paced the men's triumph of the Hanau Panthers to a DODDSEUR five-team track and field triumph here Saturday.

Hanau piled up 107 1/4 points, 20 more than host and second-place Frankfurt. Berlin, Ansbach and Zweibrücken had 30, 29 and 12, respectively.

Brenda Givens, on the basis of winning four events, helped spur the Eaglettes of Frankfurt to victory and alleviate some of the sting of the men's loss.

The Eaglettes totaled 91 1/4 points, Hanau

62, Berlin 32 1/4, Zweibrücken 25 and Ansbach 14.

Hughes took the 400 meters in 52.2 and the 800 in 2:04.

The threesome of William Averett, Joe Bailey, Gerry Bailey joined Hanau anchorman Rick McGee to take the 400-meter relay and teamed up with Mike Fink to capture the 800-meter relay.

Other double winners were Hanau's Don Clark in the weights, Frankfurt's James Frazer in the dashes, Ansbach Ed Butler in the hurdles.

Aiding Hanau was Darrell Green's 19-10 first-place leap in the long jump.

Givens swept the 50, 100, 200 meters in 6.6, 12.25, 26.4, respectively, and took the

long jump in 16-4 1/4.

Frankfurt's Lizanne Gauer was a double winner, taking the 800 meters in 2:31.6 and the 1,500 meters in 5:22.8. Also taking a pair was Berlin's Kathy Haury with tosses of 34-10 1/4 in the shot-put and 87-5 in the discus.

Frankfurt's Cheryl Lofton tacked up a

triumph in the triple jump with a 29-0 marking.

The Eaglettes got a victory in the 1600-meter relay with the quartet of Andrea Fleck, Kathy Warvl, Lisa Areheart and Rhonda King. Its time was 4:43.

Bucs capture 17 firsts in track sweep at Karlsruhe

KARLSRUHE, Germany — Baumholder tracksters, men and women, scored 17 first-place victories in sweeping a high school quadrangular meet here Saturday.

The Bucs' women tallied 10 triumphs and 86 points. Karlsruhe followed with 41, Hahn had 29 and Frankfurt International School five. Baumholder's men registered seven victories and 68 points. Karlsruhe was second with 55, FIS had 48 and Hahn six.

Cush Samuel, Paula Washington and Shannon Hughes scored doubles for the Buc women. Samuel had a 14-4 1/4 leap in the long jump and she and Washington shared the 100 meters win with a 13.9 clocking. Washington won the 50 meters in 7.2. Hughes led a Baumholder 1-2-3 sweep in the 800 meters with a 2:45.8 timing. Teammates Liz Brophy and Vera Wilcox were second and third. Hughes also won the 1500 meters in 5:40.7.

Samuel joined Paula Washington, Julie

Slagg and Pam Plehn in winning the 400-meter relay in 54.9. The team of Washington, Samucl, Plehn and Erica Sullivan took first in the 800-meter relay with a 1:57.8 clocking. Hughes teamed up with Brophy, Kathy Sundt and Slagg to take the 1600-meter relay in 4:59.3.

Michelle Jackson of Hahn chalked up a pair of victories in the weights, 30-1 1/2 in the shot-put and 96-8 in the discus.

The foursome of Johnny Jones, Wes Samuel, Terry Barefoot and Scott Sullivan won a pair of relay events for Baumholder. Jones anchored the 400-meter relay win in 46.5 and Sullivan brought the baton home in 1:36.7 in the 800-meter relay.

Three of the relay team scored individual victories. Samuel captured the 100 meters in 11.4, Sullivan the 200 in 23.5 and Jones the long jump in 17-11 1/2.

Wiesbaden gals romp to victory; Mannheim men take a squeaker

WIESBADEN — The Wiesbaden women put on a flashy show here Saturday, winning all but three events, and the Mannheim men took a hard-earned verdict over Wiesbaden in a pair of five-team track and field meets.

Cassandra Conner led the Wiesbaden women to their victory with a sizzling 6.9 clocking in the 50, a first in a mis-measured 100 meters and a 27.35 clocking in the 200 meters. She also ran the anchor leg in the 800-meter relay.

Patty Morin and Pat Boston chalked up

double wins and helped out in the relays, all three of which Wiesbaden won. Morin took the 800 and 1500 and ran a leg in the 1600. Boston turned in a 16-6 long jump and a 34-9 1/2 triple jump, both season bests, and ran a leg in both the 400 and 80 yards.

The Mannheim men took seven events, including all three relays, usually a Wiesbaden forte, to take the team crown by six points over Wiesbaden, 73-67. The Warriors had only four triumphs, but they stayed close with a flock of seconds and thirds.

Heather, Blake sparkle, but ISB triumphs

BRUSSELS — SHAPE's Rob Heather and Karen Blake sparkled individually, but International School of Brussels dominated the team picture, winning both the men's and women's competition in a high school quadrangular track and field meet here Saturday.

Both Heather and Blake chalked up a somewhat unusual quadruple, each winning the 100 meters, long jump, shot put and discus events in their respective divisions.

Heather had a season's best 129-11 in the discus and a 46-flat in the shot which didn't quite match his own year's best of last week. Blake's 15-6 long jump was one of the better marks recorded so far.

ISB won the women's scoring handily, chalking up 73 points to 43 for Bonn, 34 for SHAPE and 12 for Brussels. The men's scoring was much closer with ISB getting 68, SHAPE 58, Brussels 30 and Bonn 25.

Other double victories included ISB's Scott DeVries in the 110 meter high and 180-yard low hurdles, Brussels' Lee Smith in the 800 and 1500 meters and Maggie Culligan of ISB in the women's 50 and 200 meters.
