

USAFE Baseball Clinic Opens at Wiesbaden

WIESBADEN (S&S) — Upwards of 100 persons are expected at the 1972 USAFE Baseball Clinic which begins today at the Wiesbaden Air Base. Registration is from 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. at the Skyhook Service Club, the site of the three-day clinic.

Headlining the slate of instructors are St. Louis Cardinal pitching ace Bob Gibson, Cincinnati's heralded catcher Johnny Bench, UCLA baseball coach Art Reichle, Elston Howard, former New York Yankee catching star and presently a coach with the club and National League umpire Tom Gorman.

The multi-talented Bench won the 1970 National League Most Valuable Player award by one of the largest margins in the 40-year history of the most highly valued prize in the game. Gibson has spent his entire

major league career — 11 seasons — with the Cards. His lifetime record is 206-130, which doesn't include seven wins against two losses in three World Series. Howard joined the Yankees in 1955 and stayed with them till 1967 when he was traded to Boston. He appeared in 10

World Series. Gorman, a former lefthander with the old New York Giants, has worked in four World Series and six All-Star games. Reichle has been the head coach at UCLA for 27 seasons. Going into last season he had won 578 games while losing 460 for a .552 percentage.

In the featured match of the two-day meet, Heidelberg's Bill Melanson and Baumholder's Jim Rice clashed in the 187-pound division. Both entered the meet unbeaten. Melanson won by a 7-0 decision Friday, but Rice came back Saturday to take a 3-0 verdict.

Kevin Souser remained unbeaten for the Bucs in the 169-pound class by racking up Baumholder's only win Friday when he pinned Paul McGary in 5:33. Souser and McGary battled to a 2-2 draw Saturday.
